Hans is the Head of Economics & Data Analytics (EDA) at Vincents. Hans has over two decades of experience as a management accountant, economist, and testifying expert. He specialises in applying economic and managerial accounting frameworks to complex commercial litigation and class actions. Hans has extensive experience working in the United States as an economic consultant on large scale matters across a wide range of commercial litigation and regulatory investigations. He began his career as an economist at the Australian Federal Treasury and the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. Hans holds a Master of Economics degree from the Australian National University and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Chicago. He is also a Chartered Financial Analyst and Certified Management Accountant. His professional interests include artificial intelligence, causation, cost analytics, and lateral thinking.

Hans started the EDA unit in 2021 to build analytics capabilities aimed at expanding the evidentiary possibilities of big data in complex litigation. Over a short time, EDA has grown to several data scientists (including experts in AI). EDA not only provides analytical support to testifying experts and lawyers but also develops state-of-the-art analytics tools to support litigation. EDA is currently working on an ambitious project to create an AI assistant that can act as a virtual forensic accountant. Using LLMs with agentic workflows (an AI technique) this tool will empower lawyers to analyse financial documents in their case in a way that mimics talking to a real-life forensic accountant. In 2024 the EDA Unit was recognised as Innovator of the Year by Accountants Daily.
