JASON HARRIS

Professor of Corporate Law

Jason teaches and researches in the areas of Corporate Law, Insolvency Law, Commercial Law and Contracts at the University of Sydney Law School. His research is focused on the public and private regulation of financially distressed companies, including debt restructuring, voluntary administration, corporate governance and directors' duties during financial distress and the regulation of corporate groups. Jason's research is frequently cited in Supreme Court and Federal Court decisions as well as in Commonwealth parliamentary committees and by academic works in Australia and internationally.
