As a barrister, Michael specialises in intellectual property, information technology, privacy, trade practices, commercial and corporate law. He is a member of the IEEE, the ACM, the Copyright Society of Australia, and a member of the executive of the UNCITRAL Coordinating Committee in Australia (UNCCA).

In 2014, Michael was a recipient of the Fastcase Top 50 award for innovation in technology and law.
