ADVOCACY TIPS

1 BE POLITE

This is an important tip to remember not just in regards to how you treat the bench and your colleagues, but also the tip staff in the courtroom.





2 BE PREPARED

Know your case inside-out and be prepared to answer questions that the bench may ask.

3 BE PURPOSEFUL

Get straight to the point!
The Court or Tribunal's time is limited. In cross-examination, don't ask a question unless the answer goes to a point you are trying to make in submissions.
