The Rathswohl

According to *Rathswohl*, the following considerations should be taken into account when determining whether something may be reasonably necessary for the protection of lawful interests:

whether the purpose of the conversation was to obtain admissions in support of a legitimate purpose.






whether it was for the protection from accusations of fabricating a conversation and recording the conversation was the only practical means of refuting that allegation.

whether there were other practical means of recording the conversation. For example, bringing another person to the meeting or taking contemporaneous written file notes.





whether there's a serious dispute on foot between the parties, including where determination of the dispute would vitally depend on oral evidence and one person's word against another.
