## Pro Enhances the court's legitimacy

- Increases transparency of judicial decisions
- Allows judges to respectfully criticise the law
- Shows that arguments from both sides were seriously considered

## Con Invites challenges to the court's authority

- A split decision invites a future challenge to the majority decision
- Dissenting judgments can be used as persuasive authority in appeals, eroding finality
