LOCAL LAW-ENFORCEMENT

If the online harassment or deception falls under the provisions of the Crimes Act, it is within the jurisdiction of local police to become involved given they have the resources to do so.



THE E-SAFETY COMMISSIONER

The E-Safety Commissioner provides a complaints mechanism for Australians who experience cyberbullying, empowering them to take action and report illegal or inappropriate online content.

THE AUSTRALIAN FEDERAL POLICE

For abusive online content originating from outside Australia or outside an 'International Association of Internet Hotlines' (INHOPE) member country, the AFP is informed and becomes involved.



AUSTRALIAN CYBER SECURITY CENTRE

The ACSC offers an avenue to report cybercrimes to police through the ReportCyber reporting channel. ReportCyber can help you address online identity theft and fraud, cyber-enabled abuse and online image abuse.
