Brought by the  
shareholder on the  
company's behalf



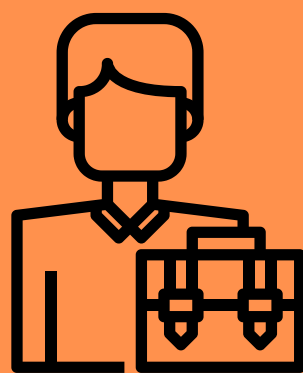
Must be granted  
leave to apply before  
beginning  
proceedings



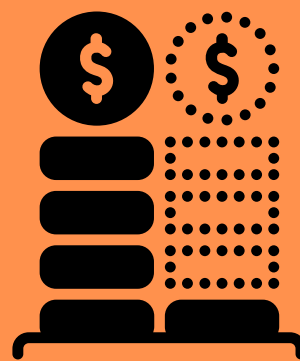
Shareholder bears the  
cost and the risk, but  
judgment is granted  
to the company



A claim brought by a  
shareholder on their own  
behalf, against the company  
or its members.



Can bring the claim  
directly, as of right



Shareholder bears the  
cost and the risk, but the  
judgment is granted to  
the shareholder  
themselves
