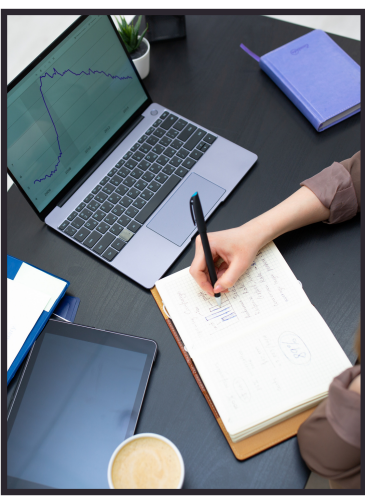
## Write Better, Not More

With the increased accessibility to relevant cases, there may be a temptation to copy long quotations into your arguments. Only bring up what's relevant and be concise.



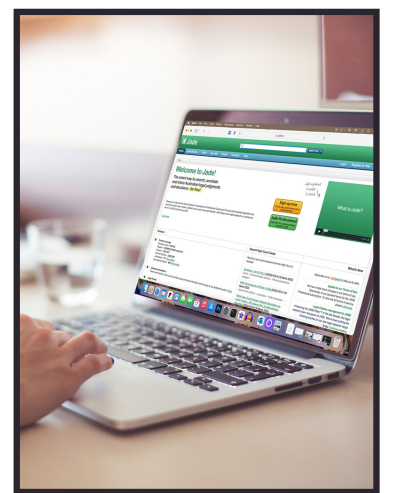
## Hybrid Model

Utilise legal databases to find relevant cases and Control + F to see the arguments and whether they're successful. Then, print out the case, read through it and annotate it physically.



## Use Jade's Features

In Jade, you can upload your submissions and it checks that citations are correct. It also creates a list of authorities. You can also click pinpoint references and it displays the relevant paragraph.



## Test Multiple Platforms

Use multiple legal research platforms to determine which one you work most effectively with. Spend time reading full cases and browsing the platforms.
