# ELDER LAW IN CONTEXT



#### **AN AGEING POPULATION**

The Australian Bureau of Statistics has reported that in 2019 almost 16% of Australia's population, that's almost 4 million Australians, were over the age of 65 and by 2037 that is expected to increase to 20%.



## **IMPORTANCE OF AGED CARE**

In the 2017/18 financial year, >1.3 million older Australians received some form of aged care:

- 7% accessed residential aged care
- 22% accessed support or care at home
- 71% lived at home without accessing government-subsidised aged care services.



## THE COST OF AGED CARE

Australian Government expenditure for aged care totalled \$18.1 billion in 2017–18. Currently, the basic daily care fee is \$52.25 per day.



# WHAT IS ELDER ABUSE?

The World Health Organisation defines elder abuse as a 'single or repeated act or lack of appropriate action occurring within any relationship where there is an expectation of trust which causes harm or distress to an older person.'



#### **ELDER ABUSE – THE STATS**

NSW Ageing and Disability Commission found that children were the perpetrators of abuse in more than 15% of cases. The most common purported types of abuse were psychological at 25.9%, with financial, neglect and physical abuse all sitting at around 20% each.
